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Purpose

To consider quotations for the supply, delivery and licensing of a new backhoe utilising the fund allocated under the Plant Replacement Program 2014- 2015 and outright purchase offers received in relation to a LG Procurement tender.

Background

The tender is for the supply and delivery of one backhoe.

The existing backhoe, CAT 428C (commissioned in 2002) is located at Euabalong Depot and is used to maintain Council's Regional and Shire roads, Aerodrome and Tip in the areas of Euabalong, Euabalong West, Mt Hope, Nymagee. It is being replaced in accordance with the Plant Replacement Schedule.

Tenders were invited by LG Procurement on 13th October 2014 and the tenders were received for the supply of the backhoe from the following tenderers.

The tenders were evaluated with the following criteria.

The knowledge of the relevant stakeholders was applied when using the criteria.

Description of Qualitative Criteria	Scale of 10
Whole of Life Costs	10 – the least whole of life cost to the Council, considering the purchase price, maintenance & operational costs and resale value.
Operator Assessment	10 – the best operator assessment of the model
Familiarity with the model	10 – have past or current experience with the brand/plant in the CSC fleet
Level of integrated support (such as parts , product and training)	10- Have service center/depot in Cobar and having overnight access to parts and services.

A further report is proceeded in Committee of the Whole Closed Council detailing the commercial information in accordance with Section 10A (2)(d)(i) of the Local Government Act 1993.

RECOMMENDATION
