A certificate of compliance remains valid for a period of 3 years from the date on which it is issued but ceases to be valid if a direction is issued under section 23 in respect of the swimming pool to which the certificate relates.

The local authority that issues a certificate of compliance in respect of a swimming pool must ensure that details of the certificate are entered on the Swimming Pool Register.

For the purposes only of any appeal proceeding arising in connection with an application under this section, the local authority is taken to have refused the application if it has not finally determined the application within 6 weeks after the application was made.
